


















Interlochen One Acts Festival (2022) **Costume Designer**

Director's Notes

I would like for costumes to not indicate to the audience a specific time or place as Pinter's story should focus more on the themes and the setting should remain amorphous so that emphasis is placed on totalitarian control and censorship. However, for the costume coordinator's sake, I have found inspiration for my costume interests by looking up 1940 prisons. To help establish the eerie, meaningless mood, I would like the costumes to be dark, solid, and dirty. I would like the women in solid prints with the women in dresses, coats, scarves, hats, and other accessories to indicate the cold. I would like the male prisoners to be in oversized long sleeve shirts and pants. The prisoners are likely barefoot with the females in boots. I anticipate that most of my costumes will need to be pulled from the costume shop if possible. The play calls for the hooded man's costume to have a hood. I would like the officers and sergeant to be wearing costumes that signify their position. I would like for there to be a subtle difference between the prison guards' costumes to highlight the hierarchy of power. I would like costumes to mimic the play by appearing amorphous, formless, unstructured, and vague. I would like the costumes' main purpose to be for warmth and protection not for stylistic or artistic expression. Unlike the rest of the play, the costumes are a means to an end and only exist to execute their function of protection.

Process

Sgot of Nelly was the first of the Fail Girls to die, followed soonafter by her sisters, Jenny June 90 Scot of and Gerty Fail in that order. Causes of death were Blunt Object Disappearance and Consumption also in that order. Of course, plenty other Fails had died long before Nelly did. Why, her own parents, Henry and Marietta Fail, drowned in the 1944 00 H+M Chicago River some thirteen years back, casualties of the Eastland Riverboat disaster. Oh, they weren't on the Eastland. Set Design

The SpongeBob Musical (2021) Assistant Set Designer + Construction

Our set was designed with the idea of modularity at its center. This show would run at the same time as 3 others during the summer, and changeovers between sets would have to be overnight. Each set piece for the show is removable and able to be stored backstage. All of the pieces are made of recycled materials to create the idea of a city made entirely of things that floated to the bottom of the sea. Hula hoops, pool noodles, bottle caps, plastic bags, and recycled cardboard make up the entirety of the set dressing, and these materials were all donations from the local community.






